Hello Adventure Unit Campers and Parents/Guardians:

Each day, camp is held at the South Windsor Parks and Recreation Department (the old Wapping Elementary School). Camp begins at **8:30 am** and ends at approximately **4:00 pm** every day (except where noted). If you are unable to attend a day of camp, please inform a counselor of your absence. Also, if early pickup or late drop off is necessary, please let one of the staff know ahead of time as it may interfere with a trip schedule. Also, for drop off and pick up please park in the back of the building (side parking lot at SWHS near the turf/stadium field).

Cell phones and or electronics are not permitted at camp. The Adventure Unit has its own cell phone for use in emergencies. Parents may contact the camp phone should they need to communicate with their camper. Cell phones are easily lost or damaged on our high adventure trips.

### To help you on your first day, here is a list of what to wear and bring:

- ePACT MEDICAL FORM – this needs to be coBrownstonempleted online
- PICK UP AUTHORIZATION – completed online through ePACT. We will ask you to look over and sign a hard copy of the pick up authorization.
- PG 13 movie viewing form signed by parent or guardian – We will ask you to fill this out when you arrive at camp.
- Lunch in a disposable bag (preferred) and a water bottle
- Comfortable shoes and appropriate clothing that is needed for the day's trip.
- Sunscreen
- Additional items for each trip will be discussed at the end of each preceding day.

\*To give permission for your camper to walk or ride their bike to and from camp, please request a waiver form from one of the Adventure Unit staff members.

# Specific Trip Information

| <b>Monday 8/15</b>                             | Welcome to our final week of camp! We're excited to meet all the new campers and see the returners! The day will consist of getting to know each other, going over rules, group games and more! Please make sure to pack a lunch.   |
| <b>Tuesday 8/16</b><br>Farmington River Tubing | Today we will be tubing on the Farmington River. Each camper will receive a life vest and a tube, together we will float down the river. There are two sets of rapids, where campers will move faster in their tube than normal. There may be times where we could possibly have to walk. Please send your child with either a pair of water shoes, crocs, old sneakers, or sandals with a back. Once we have completed the course, a bus will bring us back to the starting point. There is not an opportunity to buy any items on this trip, so please pack your child with a lunch. We will be eating prior to tubing. Finally, a waiver will need to be signed. You can find the waiver in the session letter email. You can bring it in to camp filled out on the first day, or you are welcome to fill out a copy that we will provide to you at sign in. |
| <b>Wednesday 8/17</b><br>Six Flags             | Get ready for a day of rides and fun! Food is not allowed inside the park, campers that bring a bagged lunch will eat around 10:00 am as we wait for the park to open to the public. Campers also have the option to buy food with their own money, inside the park at a later time. <b>Six Flags is now cashless. If you send your child with cash, they will need to convert it at a station within the park.</b> Campers have the option of picking what kinds of rides they would like to go on. We will not be using the waterpark at this time. For this particular trip it is best if they only bring the items that are completely necessary.   |
| <b>Thursday 8/18</b><br>On Site                | We are back on site today! Please be sure to pack a lunch.  |
| <b>Friday 8/19</b><br>VMP                      | To end our week, we will play a BIG Friday morning activity with our entire camp. We will then go to the pool to have lunch and swim. We will leave the pool at 3:00 pm and return back to camp around 3:15 pm. If you would like to pick your child up from VMP, please do so before 3:00 pm.  |
