

Dear Parents/ Guardians,

Effective June 25, 2020, the Governor's Office at the State of Connecticut has released Executive Order 7BBB. Such order states that anyone traveling into Connecticut from a state that has a new daily positive test rate higher than 10 per 100,000 residents or a state with a 10% or higher positivity rate over a 7-day rolling average are directed to self-quarantine for a 14-day period from the time of last contact within the identified state. While this Order is advisory and strongly urges visitors to Connecticut from an identified state and residents returning to Connecticut from an identified state to self-quarantine, it is up to individuals to abide by the advisory.

The Town of South Windsor and the South Windsor Parks and Recreation Department take these matters very seriously. In order for our programs to run successfully we need all of our participants and staff to continue to follow the guidelines and recommendations from the Governor's office as well as The Office of Early Childhood.

Specifically, Camp Evolution will continue to ask our screening questions on the first day that a camper and staff member arrive. Each day after that, parents and staff members will be asked to confirm that there haven't been any changes to those answers. Campers or staff who has traveled to a state that has been identified by the Governor as a state of caution will not be able to attend our program and must self-quarantine for a 14-day period before returning. We ask that our families be responsible and to inform our staff about any travel to an identified state. The safety of our campers and staff will continue to be our number one priority behind every decision and we ask that you do the same. You will be refunded and I will let our Parks and Recreation office aware of any changes necessary.
