### **OLD BUSINESS:**

- Ginny Hole shares that SWW&WW has completed an application for a grant from the Connecticut Department of Transportation, Act of Transportation microgrant program and subsequently awarded \$5,000. The \$5,000 will be used for new bikes and adaptive bikes for the towns 4<sup>th</sup> grade bike program. Ginny Hole shares with Jeff Harner that he can begin the process of researching and purchasing these bikes. Steve Wagner mentions that there may be a need for larger size helmets for the 4<sup>th</sup> grade bike program. The commission then goes on to discuss which shops they may consider when purchasing these items and where they will be stored in the future.
- John Caldwell has retired as Parks Superintendent, and Dave Turkington will be taking over in the interim.
- South Windsor Cross Town Trail updates include Director Keays sharing that she is working with the town to get the Wetland permitting in place. A meeting is scheduled for mid-May to work on the application and Director Keays is hopeful to get on the agenda for the Town Council in June.
- 4<sup>th</sup> grade bike program at Pleasant Valley School went well. Moving forward Ginny Hole suggest letting the SWPD know when the ride is happening and/or perhaps joining the ride. Eli Terry's ride is coming up on May 20, 21, 23 & 24 and Ginny Hole said they are still in need of volunteers for the event

- The Town Managers Report has a list of all the sidewalks proposed for the town. You can find it attached to the agenda on the Town Councils Commission page.
- Adopt a road program on April 13 saw 10 participants and was successful.
- SWW&WWs attended the Parks and Recreations Earth Day event.
